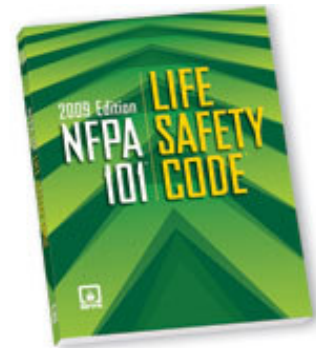

This 3-day seminar will provide an overview of NFPA 101 including the origins of the document and the evolution into the current 2009 edition. The seminar will also discuss the following:

- Requirements for new, existing and renovated buildings,
- Concept of performance based options,
- Hazard of contents,
- Means of egress,
- Provisions for doors, stairs, smoke-proof enclosures, horizontal exits, ramps, exit passageways, etc.
- Occupant load factors and calculations.
- Emergency lighting and egress markings,
- Fire protections systems and reference standards,
- Special structures and high-rise buildings,
- Provisions for building services including utilities, HVAC, smoke control, elevators and escalators and rubbish and laundry chutes.



In addition, Sean will discuss where NFPA 101 can supplement the national model codes in areas such as building rehabilitation, operating features, submitting or evaluating equivalencies, and assessing imminent fire and life safety hazards.
